Profile	Bulgaria Economic Forum (BEF) is a non-profit legal entity founded in 1998 with the main objectives to promote the business environment of Bulgaria and Southeast Europe to potential foreign investors, to facilitate the dialogue between government and business, to develop local territorial attractiveness. It currently has 40 members which are key stakeholders in Bulgarian economic and social life. Its activity covers the territory of whole Bulgaria. BEF has offices in Sofia, Montana and Kyustendil. Its members are key industrial chambers and associations, significant companies, financial institutions, public organizations, etc.
