Profile	The North-East Regional Development Agency of Romania is a non-governmental, non-profit, of public utility organization, which contributes to reducing regional disparities by stimulating the economic, social and cultural development of the North-East Region in Romania. RDA develops strategies, attracts resources, identifies and implements financing programmes and offers services for stimulating sustainable economic development, partnerships and entrepreneurial spirit. The North-East is a development region in Romania, comprising the following counties: Bacau, Botosani, lasi, Neamt, Suceava and Vaslui. The North-East RDA offers a portfolio of integrated services for regional development, built over 20 years of activity as a promoter and generator of social-economic development in the North-East Region of Romania. lasi County Council is responsible with: - establishment and management of local public services of county interest: education of children with special needs; social services for child protection, people with disabilities, other people and groups with social needs; health; culture; youth; public order and emergency situations; environment protection, waste management, rehabilitation of cultural and natural patrimony, public county roads, water and waste water network, tourism, development of lasi International Airport, - adoption of strategies and programs for the economic and social development of the county, - adoption, based on the opinion of administrative-territorial units, projects of land arrangement and urban development.









lasi County Council is the legal owner and manager of the county roads and is responsible with the construction, maintenance and modernization of roads and bridges.

lasi County Council is also empowered by law to manage 5 county hospitals. It is the owner of the buildings and lands where the hospitals are located. Thus, lasi County Council is responsible with the rehabilitation, modernization and endowment of the county hospitals.
